One-to-one Community Match Program

The 1:1 Community match is the 'traditional' BBBS program; matching a youth (Little) with a caring, supportive adult mentor (Big) in the community. Bigs and Littles spend time together, attend BBBSGB group programs and build developmental relationships which express care, challenge growth, provide support. share power and expand possibilities.

Outdoor Wellness Program

Our Outdoor Wellness program is offered to mentees and mentors one Saturday a month and allows Bigs, Littles and families alike to connect in the great outdoors. The program promotes physical and mental well-being through activities such as, snowshoeing, canoeing, plant identification, seasonal artwork, foraging, games and much more. In 2022, over 300 camp seats were filled.



Big Bunch Program

Big Bunch is a monthly event, for all Bigs & Littles to come together and have some fun. These group activities initially started to ensure Littles on the waitlist felt supported and had some fun while waiting to be matched with a caring Big. The photo to the left is from a group outing this past Fall.



BBBSGB offers a number of in-school programs including a newly launched tutoring program called 'Learn It!'. 'Learn It!' supports youth academic achievements outside the classroom with 92% of learners reporting increasing confident in their academic work by program completion. With a focus on numeracy and literacy, youth in grades three to eight learn new skills in a fun, creative, and youth-focused learning environment.
